#### Uses:

Grip Bond  $1^{\text{TM}}$  is an excellent general purpose adhesive for wood surfaces such as, flush doors, wood furniture and cabinets to improve adhesion also in composite wood MDF "medium density fiberboard" for indoor use.

# **Surface Preparation:**

All surfaces must be dry, clean and free of contaminants such as dirt, grease, mildew, oil, loose or badly cracked paint, etc. Sanding the surfaces prior to application will increase a good bonding strength. Appropriate clamp pressure is essential for a successful bond.

# **Method of Application:**

Apply a heavy coat of Lanco $^{\odot}$  Grip Bond 1<sup>TM</sup> to both surfaces being bonded. For tight materials such as maple, brick, oak, etc.; allow 2 to 3 minutes for assembly time before pressing together.

Glue coming out from the joint may make the area around the joint difficult to stain. Sanding the area with glue will help clean the surface, but, is recommended to cover those areas that are around, with tape prior the application.

#### Pressure:

Appropriate clamp pressure is essential for a successful bond. Parts must remain under pressure of about 100 psi, which is generally adequate, except for rough or warped surfaces. Applying pressure in time periods from 15 to 30 minutes, are required for best bond.

## **Storage Information:**

Protect from freezing; store in a cool, dry place at room temperature. Product must be used within one year of purchase.

# Danger/Warning:

Use only with adequate ventilation. Ventilation must be sufficient to limit exposure below S.D.S. limits.

**Caution:** Close container tightly after each use. Provide adequate ventilation during application and drying cycle.
